



FAST FALCONS DIRECTOR OF ATHLETE DEVELOPMENT

The candidate will direct FAST FALCONS age group swimming programs from entry-level competitive swimming through development into senior swimming. This candidate will serve as the lead assistant in planning and coaching senior programming and lead the age group programs on deck, supervise assistant group coaches, and as a coach and function as a program coordinator in an administrative role. In addition, the candidate will implement FAST's dryland program, attend regular swim meets, and cover other training groups as the coaching staff needs. A strong background in competitive swimming and prior coaching experience is necessary. In addition to on-deck coaching duties, the applicant will have team-related administrative responsibilities in meet entries, team communication, and scheduling. This coach will also be involved with camps and clinics implemented by FAST.
