According to the Florida Department of Health, Florida had the highest unintentional drowning death rate among children ages 0 to 9 from 2017 to 2019. Cannonball Kidz will provide eight free swim lessons to all Marion County students in 3rd grade for the 2022-23 school year – including students enrolled in public, private, virtual, and home schools.
